RESOLUTION NO. 06-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WHATCOM COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 13, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, THIS RESOLUTION IS TO ADDRESS HIGH USAGE BILLING TO ENCOURAGE WATER CONSERVATION, REFER TO 01-2013 FOR ADDITIONAL POLICIES.

WHEREAS The Board of Commissioners of Whatcom County Water District # 13 wants to encourage water conservation by the ratepayers of Whatcom County Water District No. 13.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Whatcom Water District No. 13 as follows:

Water Rates

Water Service Base Rate: \$46.00 per billing cycle (bill bi-monthly) effective 11/1/23 billing.

Water Use Rate (commodity or volume charge):

Block 1: (0-15,000 Gallons @ \$46.00 flat rate bi-monthly)

Block 2: (15,001 Gallons to 25,000 Gallons) @ \$ 1.00 per thousand gallons of usage, in addition to the \$ 46.00 base rate.

Block 3: (25,001 Gallons to 30,000 Gallons) @ \$ 3.00 per thousand gallons of usage, in addition to the \$ 46.00 base rate.

Block 4: (30,001 Gallons and above) @ \$6.00 per thousand gallons of usage, in addition to the \$46.00 base rate.


A 10% penalty is applied to your account if you are late paying your bill.

This new rate schedule which includes commodity rates will promote conservation and encourage customers to address high water usage.

The District shall adjust the commodity charge for high water bills due to a leak when a customer meets all requirements stated in this resolution to be eligible for a bill adjustment. When the district observes a leak or high usage it will attempt to notify the occupant or property owner, but it shall remain the property owners' responsibility to discover and repair any leak. To be eligible, the owner must notify the district, complete the repairs, and then submit a signed adjustment request within sixty (60) days. Leaks need to be reported, repaired, within sixty (60) days of occurrence.


Once the leak has been repaired and consumption falls below block 2 & 3 quantities, the commodity charge regarding the leak will be removed from the account.
